DAYS 1 AND 2: HEBREWS 3:7-11—LESSONS FROM THE PAST

1. a. Why do you think the author used the words, “*as the Holy Spirit says,*” in verse 7?

b. In 10 words or less, what is the message of verses 7-11?
2. In Psalm 78:32-37, what characteristics are revealed about the Israelites during the Exodus period?
3. a. Who is the speaker in verse 10?

b. Explain to the best of your ability these phrases from verses 10-11:
 - 1) “*They always go astray in their heart.*”
 - 2) “*They have not known My ways.*”
 - 3) “*They shall not enter My rest.*”

DAY 3: HEBREWS 3:12-14—COUNSEL FOR THE PRESENT

4. Read 2 Peter 1:5-8 with Hebrews 3:12. From these passages, what can believers do to guard their hearts so they don't “*fall away from the living God*”?
5. Read Ephesians 4:29-32 with Hebrews 3:13. From these verses, what can believers do to encourage and help one another mature in faith?
6. What are the similarities between Hebrews 3:6 and 3:14?
