1. Pray for In Christ Singapore, for the mission of the church. Pray that we be a church that welcomes the presence of God. We pray for the officials as they undertake reconstruction of the access pathways, and put in place measures and aids for the large community whose livelihoods have been impacted by the disruption.
14. We remember those who are looking for employment and job security in the midst of reports of retrenchments, mergers and economic uncertainties. We pray that You provide them with a peace and assurance that can only come from You. May You guide them in their search and show them just where they are meant to be. We praise You for the work You are doing in our lives and thank You for the favour within our church community.
15. We continue to lift the people caught in the Israel-Gaza conflict. We pray for the people on the ground, as they face severe food shortages and have a lack of healthcare and sanitation. Even as the fighting continues on many fronts, we

continue to pray that the fragile peace and security internationally be sustained as the many different nations take sides, and racial tensions are taut.

16. Pray that the political situations will stabilise in each of these regions (Israel-Gaza, Russia-Ukraine, North-South Korea, Taiwan-China). We pray for wisdom amongst the leaders, that they will be able to look beyond their political differences and exercise care for the regions.
